

co-heirs, he gave up his rights of succession to Gervais, his brother, on 10 February 1689 (Rageot's records). Antoine Bisson and Ursule Trud, his wife, died at St-Antoine-de-Tilly, where they were buried, he on 27 January 1705; she the 4th of December 1701, dying suddenly according to the act of sepulture. An Ordonnance of the Intendant disposed of their estate on 8 February 1713. (Ord. Int., I, 125). Children:
